Reminder:

According to City Ordinance, all trash must be bagged & placed in approved containers.

Recycling Options

Do your part in eliminating excessive landfill waste by reducing, reusing & recycling items.

There are several free-cycle websites and local non-profits that will accept clean, usable clothing and other household items.



Metals, aluminum and other items can

be recycled at various local locations, as well.

Electronics should be considered e-waste. Watch for an upcoming collection day where you can recycle household electronics and keep them out of the landfill.

Labette County Office (in Oswego) currently has a Hazardous Household Waste Collection monthly, call for details.

The City is currently working to provide more recycling options in the near future.

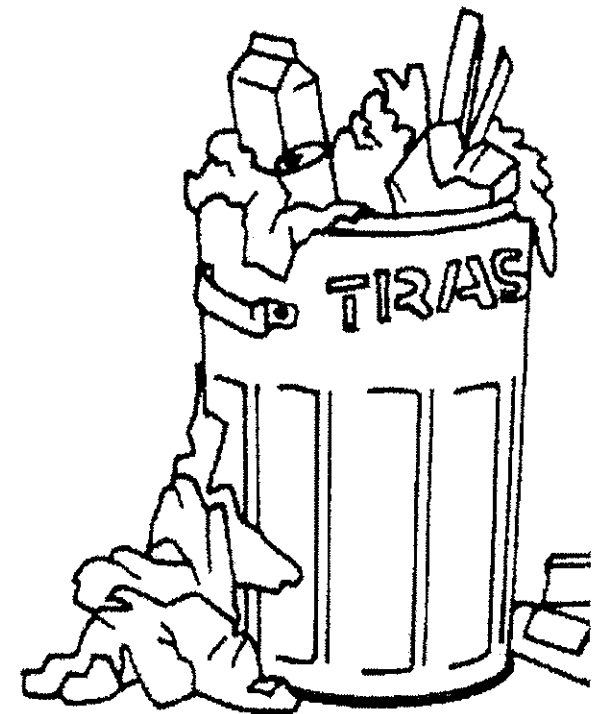
How do I schedule a pick-up?

Call (620) 421-7010 before 9 a.m. to request bulk trash pick-up. If your material is not picked up on your scheduled day, call the Utility Department on the following Tuesday.

When will my Bulk Trash be collected?

Bulk Trash Pick-up will occur on each Monday. Mondays which fall on holidays are excluded from this schedule, and will be picked up the next regular bulk Monday.

Things you should know about the City's Bulk Trash Policy!

How does Bulk Pick-up Work?

There are two easy steps to getting your bulk trash picked up on Mondays. Please remember that Bulk Trash does not run on holidays.

1. Call 421-7010 to schedule your pick-up before 9 a.m. on Monday. *(If your bulk material did not get picked up, call the Utility office the following Tuesday.)*
2. Approved & separated bulk materials can only be placed on the curb the weekend before Monday pick-up.

Bulk Material that can be left on Curb for Monday Pick-up *(must call to schedule)*

- 10 or more bags of yard waste, leaves, grass clippings, etc. *(Less than 10 should be set out with regular trash service.)*
- Sofas, Mattresses, Box Springs, Dressers, Tables and other large furniture items
- Household Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, microwaves, stoves, water heaters, air conditioners with the following restrictions:
 - a) Doors must be removed from all appliances
 - b) All food and material must be removed from within the units
 - c) Appliances containing compressors will be subject to removal costs (see fee schedule). When scheduling an appliance pick-up, utility customers must provide their name, address, and type of appliance.

Continued Bulk for Curb Pick-up

- Car, trailer, & pick-up truck tires.
 - a) See Fee Schedule
 - b) When scheduling a tire pick-up, utility customers must provide their name, address, and number of tires.
 - ****Tree Limbs & Brush** *(bundles less than 4 feet in length, & 12 inches in diameter)* normal yard maintenance quantities; Thorny vegetation must be wrapped in cardboard or several layers of paper to prevent injury to collectors. *(Small quantities can be placed with regular trash.)* Trees and brush can be hauled out to the Tree Dump as well.
 - ****Carpet & Padding Materials** *(taped & cut into 4 ft. widths, 12 inches in diameter)*
- **One average size person must be able to easily handle the items.**

Rules for Dumpster Rental:

- Materials must be contained in the dumpster.
- Dumpsters are scheduled through the City of Parsons Utilities Department & are subject to restrictions as detailed below.
- The dumpsters are subject to charges per the fee schedule in this brochure.
- Dumpsters that are overloaded by weight or volume are subject to reloading by the responsible party.
- A two-week time limit is placed on all dumpsters *(unless there is a surplus of dumpsters available)*.
- All customers who do not have an active water account must pre-pay per the fee schedule, & are subject to the two-week time limit regardless of the number of dumps prepaid.

Material to be placed in Dumpsters:

The following items are approved bulk materials required to be placed in a dumpster for removal.

- Contractor/Landlord generated construction debris
- Whole house/structure clean out or clean-up
- Non-contractor owner/renter occupied single room rehabilitation/remodel of porch, deck, or similar project.

DO NOT Include these Items:

The following materials are not approved for bulk trash pick-up:

- Regular household garbage, trash or rubbish *(These items should be placed with your regular trash service.)*
- Hazardous Materials
- Commercial Waste
- Bricks, Rocks, Blocks, other Concrete debris
- Glass
- Anything with a Title of Ownership *(boats, cars, ATVs, campers, motorcycles)*
- Debris contaminated with human fluids or waste of any kind
- Shingles, tar paper, or other roofing material
- Whole trees, wholesale landscape removal

Unapproved material placed at the curb for pick-up is subject to code violation enforcement.
